### **HOW WELL ATTENDED ARE THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN COMMITTEE AND HOW MUCH IS IT COSTING THE CITY?**

We happened to stop by The Town and Country Comprehensive Planning meeting at the Longview Farmhouse on September 27. I was told the crowd was the largest so far in the three months of meetings to get resident input on the future of development. If it was the largest it was pretty sad. There were maybe a dozen residents not counting one elected official (Tiffany Frautschi) and a member of the Planning and Zoning Commission. Plus Fred “Tax Cheat” Meyland-Smith wasn’t there.



An hour after the start of the meeting that number of 12 was cut in half. We mentioned “Illinois License Plate” Fred Meyland-Smith’s absence because at the Aldermanic meeting prior to this Committee meeting Meyland-Smith gave an impassioned tirade about how important this meeting was to attend adding he would be there despite September 27 being his 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

Ward-2 Ald. Tiffany Frautschi was at the meeting and later said she was in no way filling in for the absent Meyland-Smith.



The amazing thing was that with just 12 or so residents in the room you could not hear anything, due to the bad acoustics in the room. I walked in about 30 minutes into the meeting and saw people around two tables. The closest table had P&Z Chairman Ron Cima and local longtime flake Mariette Parker screaming at each other.



**FPA Group:** The City budgeted \$90,000 for the consultants on this project, where a big turnout is 12 people. The FPA Group stands for Facilitation + Planning + Action.

The FPA Group clearly has its fingers on the pulse of the suburbs and understands suburban issues. Below is their headquarters on Hickory Street in far South St. Louis.

The woman with her back to the group of 10 residents and an alderwoman is Julie Padberg-White. She gets \$175 an hour, but only \$150 for these meetings. The woman watching Padberg-White is Cary Bundy. She gets \$125 an hour. This meeting was at least two hours long or \$550. I don't know if they got travel time pay, but it is allowed.

**MORE MEDICAID FRAUD INVOLVING TOWN & COUNTRY RESIDENTS:** How do you afford super sized houses? Cheat the Federal Government is maybe one way.

This gets a little complicated. See if you can follow it. Dr. Abid Nisar lives at 13300 Thornhill Drive in Town and Country. Nisar and Town and Country Ald. Fred Meyland-Smith both claim they are Illinois residents and license their cars in Illinois to avoid Missouri and Town and Country sales taxes and St. Louis County annual personal property taxes. Nisar has an office in Illinois along with one in Missouri. Meyland-Smith owns property in Northern Illinois and of course claims to be a Missouri resident as he is a Missouri elected official.

Nisar bought the property at 13300 Thornhill in 2005. He also bought a second lot and then in 2006 began to build a massive 15,727 square foot 22-room house on 2.8 acres, estimated to be worth \$3,100,000.

At the same time he bought the property at 13300 Thornhill Drive, he bought one more house west on Thornhill Drive in 2004 at 13354 Thornhill. He had already owned the house at 13406 Thornhill. At first the properties were in names of Nisar and his wife, Rashda. Then Nidar put the properties under a company name of ANS Properties and then under a LCC called West County Property Group.

In May of 2012 Nidar pled guilty in Federal Court to a misdemeanor of importing cancer drugs from the Middle East and then relabeling them as American drugs and billing Medicare for non-existent American drugs. He was fined \$25,000 and ordered to pay back Medicare \$1,000,336. He also had his medical licenses in Illinois and Missouri suspended, plus he was ineligible for seven years to participate in Medicare or Medicaid programs.

In September of 2018 in Federal Court, Rehan Rana, the Pharmacy Manager for Attique at Imran Pharmacy, pled guilty to a medical service kickback operation and failing to pay taxes on \$3,900,000 of income over a three year period. Rana, who lives in Ellisville will be sentenced in December.

**THE SECRET \$100,000. ALMOST NOBODY KNEW ABOUT IT.** At the October 8 Town and Country Board of Aldermen pre-meeting Tax Cheater Fred Meyland-Smith announced that BJC (Barnes, Jewish, Children's) hospital group has given the city \$100,000 to go toward landscaping in the area of I-64 and Mason Road. The work of course would be done on Missouri Department of Transportation property. BJC built a children's surgical center at the intersection on land that used to be occupied by the Missouri Highway Patrol Troop C Headquarters.

Fred also announced that Lutheran Services, who operates the retirement/assisted living/nursing home across the highway from the BJC building is giving \$25,000.

Then all of a sudden it was mentioned that BJC gave the City \$100,000 back on January 10, 2018 and none of the elected officials other than Fred "I have avoided paying local taxes on my car by getting Illinois license plates" Meyland-Smith knew about it. The Finance Director and City Administrator were aware of the \$100,000 sitting in the bank account, but the other elected officials or any member of the public were not. This is an odd way to run an allegedly "transparent government."

"Mason Road and Highway 40 (Fred is unaware that the highway has been I-64 for sometime) is the front door to the city. (In reality the front door since the city was incorporated as a village in 1950 has been Clayton Road at Bopp Road.) It is the least attractive intersection from Spoede Road to O'Fallon, Missouri," proclaimed Meyland-Smith.

Apparently Fred thinks the cheaply built Bi-State/Metro Transit Bus Terminal on I-64 at Ballas plus the Ameren/UE Power Substation are very attractive not to mention the MoDot property on Highway 141 just before I-64 where dump trucks and Motorist Assist trucks are parked on both sides of a one-story metal building as extremely attractive.

"Two 'Not for Profits' have given gifts to the City. BJC (A not-for-profit?...ask someone after they get a \$45,000 bill for a five-day stay at a BJC hospital) gave a \$100,000 gift to the beautification of the city and Lutheran Senior Services gave \$25,000. We need to ask the Ways and Means Committee for \$20,000 for a landscape architect," added Illinois-Fred.

Alderman Matt Reutter asked about when BJC made the donation and found out it was on January 10, 2018 or 10 months ago.

“It would have been inappropriate to disclose that (the BJC gift) until we were done trying to get other gifts,” said Fred “I bought a new car and didn’t pay city or state sales tax” Meyland-Smith.

In a transparent government unlike a secret one like in Town & Country, potential gift givers would be aware of gifts already received for a project as would elected officials and the public.

Ald. Sue Allen had attended the Ward-2 Forum that morning held by Ald. Tiffany Frautschi and Ald. Lindsey Butler. She heard residents ask if BJC when they got zoning changes for their building had not already agree to provide beautification landscaping and she asked that question. This brought on the ire of Fred “I’m an elected official in Missouri, but claim to be an Illinois resident to avoid taxes on my new car” Meyland-Smith.

“Where in the world would that come from,” snarled Meyland-Smith at Allen who was sitting next to him.



“I just wanted to thank you for your work,” Mayor/Cigarette Lobbyist Jon Dalton said earlier to Meyland-Smith apparently congratulating him on hiding \$100,000 from the public, alderpersons and potential gift donors.

Ald. Jon Benigas said he remembered there was no contract with BJC to provide beautification landscaping off their property, but saying, “I remember discussions about that corridor being our front door.”

This brought Mayor Jon Dalton to comment. Remember after being kicked out of his house and living in an apartment in Clayton before renting a condo in Town and Country, Dalton refused to tell elected officials and the public where he was living.

“Shame on us to turn this type of gift into some kind of back channel deal,” exclaimed Dalton, who apparently thinks keeping the citizens in the dark about large money transitions at City Hall conducted by a senior alderman, is not a back channel deal.



Dalton was not done bad mouthing elected officials who thought the public and potential gift givers should have known what was going 10 months earlier. “I’m sickened by this conversation,” said Dalton bad mouthing those who were trying to practice good government.

I asked after the regular Aldermanic meeting of people sitting near Dalton if he appeared to be ready to barf after being “sickened” by the discussion by elected officials being caught by surprised that \$100-grand had been hidden from them.

Frankly I was a little disappointed in Sue Allen who served three terms in the Missouri House of Representatives and should have experience of retorting to a loud mouth politician or a lobbyist, which fits the description of Dalton to a “T.” It would also be nice if they would pass a resolution saying that staff will make all donations over \$500 public so Meyland-Smtih will stop hiding six-figure deposits.

#### **ALDERPERSONS DO 180-DEGREE TURNS OVER PAYING LATEST TOWN**

**SQUARE PROPOSED BILL:** Several aldermen stated in the discussion how they were for giving Brinkman Contractor another **\$92,439** for more landscaping on the Town Square Property and on neighbors’ property. **\$287,229** had already been budgeted.

“We promised every one of our property owners (owners of property abutting the Town Square Project) we would provide a landscape plan for them. I feel we have committed to these property owners a landscape plan to protect their property. I’m totally supportive of this,” said Ald. Skip Manage, who chaired the Town Square Task Force

pack in 2015. “Our next meeting is in 3-weeks (actually in 2-weeks) and if we wait we will get hit with delay fees,” he claimed, but would soon change his mind.

The Fred “Tax Chest” Meyland-Smith chimed in.

“Don’t consider not spending city money on private property. I don’t think it is fair to change the Foul Poles in the 5<sup>th</sup> Inning. I feel a sense of urgency in starting this, ” said Meyland-Smith, in a comment that made no sense whatsoever. Foul poles are on the foul lines. The only change you can make to them is to make them taller or shorter.

#### **COMMENTS ON THE OTHER SIDE:**

**Jon Benigas:** “I think I have reached my limit on the expenses on this project. If this was originally proposed as a \$9,000,000 project that might be a park I’d vote against it. I’m opposed to it (the additional \$92,439).”





**Matt Reutter:** “It is concerning to pay for things on private property.”

**Sue Allen:** “You don’t use taxpayer dollars to benefit private property. I don’t know if I want to pass something and read what it is about later.”


**Lindsey Butler** (who lives directly behind the Town Square project on King’s Glen): My neighbors were ready to go on this sometime ago. The Anderson family; (former

alderwoman Amy Anderson who Butler was her campaign manager) I like the family, but I have problems with money spent on their property and on Clayton Road.

The purple area is the edge of the Town Square. The pointed section that does not abut any of the Town Square is the back of the Anderson's lot on Rutherford Lane. Under the \$92,439 budget increase the Andersons would get five new trees and honeysuckle removal not associated with the Town Square.



The area above that looks like a very long penis is honeysuckle that abuts Clayton Road at a house under construction and does not touch the Town Square property. But a portion of the \$92,439 would be used to eradicate the honeysuckle.

The top 2 photos are the side yard at 1 Rutherford Lane where city money was proposed to be spent to remove all honeysuckle and do a 3-year eradication. This section of the lot only borders Clayton Road. The question raised at the BOA meeting was “Why the hell should public money be used for this?”

**Tiffany Frautschi:** “Once the Town Square is complete with the landscaping already budgeted, if additional landscaping is needed it could be competitively bid out.

**Lynn Wright** (to Services Director Craig Wilde): “Craig can you move ahead without the change order?”

**Craig Wilde:** “If the change order is denied we will have to go back to Loomis (landscaping consultant). In some fashion we could start. It is somewhat troubling not having a destination.”

While Brinkman Construction is building the Town Square, Brinkman Holdings purchased the front center of the property and is building a commercial building for a restaurant, ice cream store and shops. It is on land now owned by Brinkman. However there is \$10,598 in the bill of the \$92,439 to do landscaping on Brinkman’s property.

**Lindsey Butler:** “This is not us not providing what was promised. \$10,598 was never promised for landscaping on Brinkman owned property. We should keep trying to take care of our property and not Brinkman’s property.”

Skip Manage then introduce a motion to continue the \$92,439 change order indefinitely, which would basically kill it. Before it could be voted on it was decided to continue it two weeks to the next meeting and to tell Brinkman Construction they need to use the \$287,000 already budgeted and ask for plans to review.

Lindsey Butler and Matt Reutter wanted to use common sense and simply vote down the \$92,439 change order. The vote to continue the matter for two weeks was 6-2 with Butler and Reutter voting against it.


February of 2010 she was arrested for DWI in St. Louis and convicted in October of 2010.

A week before Thanksgiving 2017, on November 16 Lane was driving on Olive Blvd. near Creve Coeur Mill Road when Chesterfield Police Officer Matt Adams stopped her after she committed several traffic violations. She appeared to be drunk. She failed field sobriety tests, refused to take a field breath test and later refused to take a breath test at the police station. Since a third DWI is a felony, Officer Adams obtained a search warrant for a blood draw. The BAC results showed the 4-foot-10 inch 105 pound Lane had a BAC level of .121%.

In March of 2018 she was charged in Circuit Court with Felony Persistent DWI.

**OUTCOME:** On July 25, 2018 Lane pled guilty before Judge Burton. She was allowed to enter a DWI Special Program. She was not convicted and the case was continued for three years for sentencing.

Since there was no actual conviction and since Lane was not sentenced we could not obtain a police report reference the incident. Instead we obtained the Probable Cause information from the court files.

**SHOPLIFTER IN 2016 FROM THE CHESTERFIELD OUTLET MALL, PLEADS GUILTY IN JULY AND THEN GOES ON ROBBERY SPREE BRINGING FEDERAL CHARGES:** Markese Watkins is unique. He is one of the few people ever caught

shoplifting at the Sunglass Hut. Two years later after pleading guilty he is involved in a number of armed robberies with a AK-47 and a pistol. Here is our write up of the Chesterfield incident.

**MAN CARRYING A PURSE WITH A FEMALE PARTNER CAUGHT WITH JUST STOLEN SHOES STICK OUT OF THE PURSE** Beside the stolen shoes from Famous Footwear, a complete search of the purse showed that Markese Watkins, 26, of St. Louis had also just stolen three pairs of Sunglasses from the Sunglass Hut in the Premium Outlet Mall.

On Saturday May 28, 2016 Chesterfield Police Officers assigned to the Retail Squad responded to a call of a theft that just occurred from the Famous Footwear Store in the Premium Outlet Mall. Before arriving the call was updated and officers were told the male and female suspects were at the Sunglass Hut, a frequent victim of shoplifters.

Officers Meyer and Mueller arrived and were told by the Famous Footwear manager that the suspects left the Sunglass Hut and were in the Food Court.

Markese Watkins and Monyette Hammond, 26 of St. Louis, were stopped leaving the Food Court. Officer Meyer could see brand new shoes in the large purse being carried by Watkins.


Officers recovered two pairs of stolen Nike tennis shoes valued at \$144.98. A further search of the purse revealed three pairs of sunglass valued at \$565.

There were outstanding arrest warrants from municipal courts for both Watkins and Hammond.

A check of store video at the Sunglass Hut showed Watkins stealing one pair the sunglasses and Hammonds stealing the others.

At the police station Watkins gave a statement that he was doing all the thefts and Hammond was unaware of the thefts.

Hammond said the same thing until she was confronted with the video evidence of her stealing two pairs of sunglasses. She then confessed to the offense.

**HAMMOND:** Hammond has three outstanding traffic warrants from Creve Coeur including Driving While Revoked.

**WATKINS:** He has a number of minor traffic charges from North County Municipal Police forces. He also has these cases that have all resulted in arrest warrants being issued:

**OUTCOME:** Watkins was charged with Felony Theft for the two shoplifting incidents. On 07/16/18 the charges were reduced to by the County prosecutor to two misdemeanors. Watkins pled guilty and was sentenced to 10 days in jail and was given credit for the time in jail pending his plea. The case against Hammond was dropped.

**Watkins was charged on October 9, 2018 was being one of four men committing 12 or more armed robberies in the St. Louis area with automatic weapons.**

This is from Robert Patrick's article in the Post-Dispatch about the Federal charges:

FBI Special Agent Bastian Freund, in an affidavit filed in support of those charges, says the men robbed retail stores, cellphone stores, pizza restaurants, and a liquor store between Aug. 25 and Sept. 30. The robbers' clothes, guns and methods in the robberies are similar. One usually carries a purple and black semiautomatic handgun and another an AK-47 style rifle. They often ask employees to open the safe, and then steal wallets and cellphones from the employees, Freund wrote.

A number of victims of the string of robberies were pizza shops and their employees.
