### KING DALTON TRYING TO STACK THE BOARD WITH LOYAL SUBJECTS



In the Town and Country Ward 2 Alderman race, Mayor John "the King" Dalton (left) is working to get a loyal subject, Laura Baer (right), elected versus the independent thinker and incumbent Tiffany Frautschi (below right). They cut down a cedar that was probably at least one hundred years old. Lynn Wright, Alderman from Ward One, decided with her Parks and Trails Commission that this sidewalk was just not up to Town and Country standards. It had to be wider, prettier and UNSAFE! Oh there is a lot of finger pointing going around on this one. There is something like 600 emails!

So the Parks and Trails Commission wanted the trail to go around the most dangerous dog leg curve in Town and Country. The wrought iron fences for Lochinvar and Buckland Hall are wrecked more often than they are fixed. See photos below.

The Parks and Trails Commission of which Adam Baer, husband of Laura Baer is a member, this Commission didn't want to listen to St. Louis County about their safety concerns. The Parks and Trails bunch wanted beauty over safety. Meyland-Smith, with his Illinois plates on his personal vehicles to avoid personal property tax, isn't the most principled person and anything he says (and being the board's resident windbag, he says plenty) should taken with a grain – no, a shaker – of salt.

Upon his RETIREMENT, Chief Hoelzer issued this statement. Notice in it, **he says he is retiring**. Why would Fred Meyland-Smith go around blatantly stating falsehoods? Could he be just another loyal subject doing King Dalton's bidding?

*And the work, the pursuit of justice, and the display of exemplary service and protection will continue long after I am gone.*


