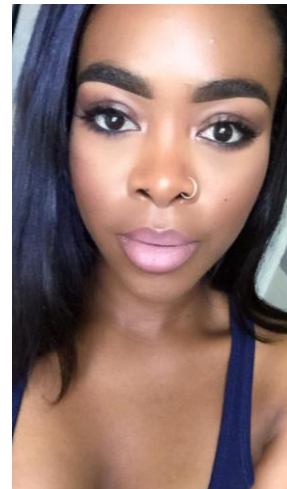

HERE IS ANOTHER GOOD EXAMPLE: On Saturday November 14, 2020 at 2:01 in the morning 28-year-old Ambra Leachman of Kirkwood was doing 100 MPH on I-270 at Clayton Road. She was also drunk.

She pled guilty to both charges last week on March 26, 2021.

Being drunk and driving 100 MPH got her a “No Fine,” “No Points,” and “No Permanent Record” SIS probation. However, she did get a \$466.50 fine and points for the 100 MPH. You can read more about this case later this year in a future “Drunks & Thieves” article.

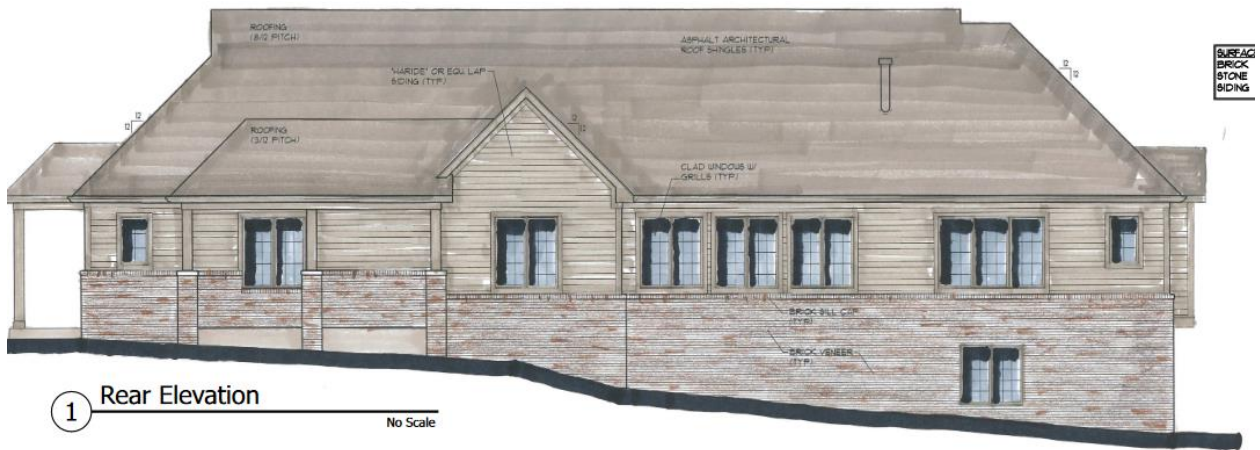

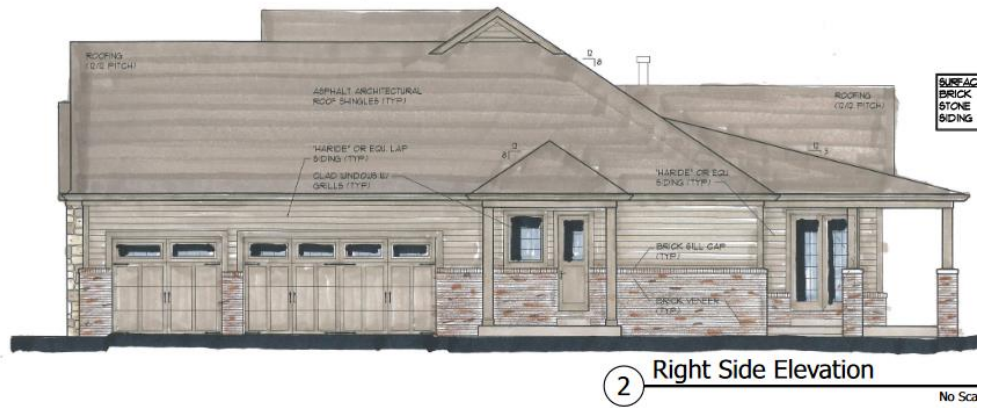

APPARENTLY READS OUR WEBSITE: Schenberg has claimed he has accepted only two campaign contributions in 2020 and none in 2021 in his race to defeat Barb McGuinness for the Ward-1 Chesterfield City Council Seat.

However in a require filing 8-days before election he was nice enough to mention me by name, I think and leave me a message.

Her only contribution was \$500 from McBride and Sons home builders, who will certainly have projects before the Council in the next two years.

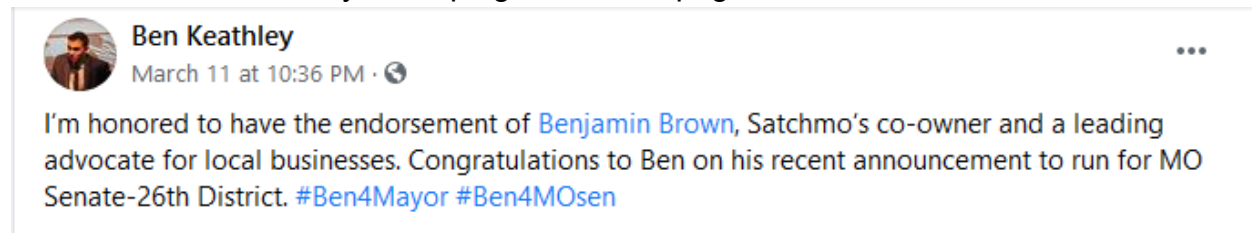

Schenberg sounds like a Trump robot. Here is what his website states about COVID:

Science tells us that COVID affects our older population far more and far worse than our under 50 residents. Science also tells us that COVID can't survive in sunlight and being outside and socially distanced is completely safe for those not otherwise at risk. I support every effort to protect our most vulnerable residents and follow all mandated guidelines. At the same time however, I think younger adults and children should follow the science and be allowed to be outdoors.

I'm not sure what scientist Gene is talking about. Is it Donald Trump, PhD, Dr. Ted Cruz, Josh Hawley or Rep. Mary Taylor Greene when he reports sunlight kills COVID-19.

However, Schenberg is the only candidate we know of that will send messages of "FU (fuck you) Hoffman" on official State of Missouri documents.

Here is a column from 2012 I wrote about Schenberg wanting the city to allow residents to shoot squirrels.

The Second Amendment Is Not About Squirrels

Former councilman has a fractured view of the Bill of Rights.

I don't consider former Chesterfield Ward 1 Councilman Gene Schenberg much of a Constitutional scholar.

Schenberg is trying to sell his position that the Second Amendment of the Constitution gives him the right to shoot projectiles from a gun at squirrels to protect his house in the Greenfield Village subdivision.

Schenberg specifically seems to think opening a window and taking a shot at a squirrel with a .177 caliber pellet gun or a .22 caliber rifle is every American's right.

A number of his neighbors think otherwise.

Unbelievably, Chesterfield founding father and current Ward 1 Councilman Barry Flachsbart is buying into this nonsense. He's against a proposal to make it illegal to fire a pellet gun within 150 yards of a house.

The bill is up for a vote on Wednesday, January 18.

Most people over the last 200 years have figured that the Second Amendment giving citizens the right to bear arms was to protect themselves from invading British soldiers.

I have to believe most of the squirrels in Greenfield Village are American born.

Over the years, the scope of the Second Amendment was enlarged to allow Americans to protect themselves from criminals, especially in the early 1800s when law enforcement was virtually non-existent across much of the country.

During the Civil War, the Second Amendment came into play again allowing people to protect themselves from invasions by armed people who ate grits.

In more recent times, Americans need the right to protect themselves from armed criminals.

The Castle Rule of law allows people to use deadly force to protect themselves from home invasions by people—not rodents.

I have dealt with squirrels in the past, having owned homes in Kansas City, suburban Washington, D.C. and West St. Louis County.

Here is what I have done to protect my houses:

- Maintained the house so squirrels could not get in.
- Did not store items like dog food or bird seed in the garage where it might attract rodents.
- Owned at least one dog whose avowed enemies are rodents, especially squirrels.

But with Schenberg's theory of home protection, he has a right to use high grade plastic explosives for voles and moles, and take pot shots with a double barrel shotgun at birds flying across his property line, perhaps fearing they will nest in his chimney.

Cities across the country are hiring companies under police oversight to safely shoot deer that have overpopulated suburbs, but they are not allowing people living in these residential areas to take potshots at Bucks and Does with high power hunting rifles.

But considering Schenberg's approach, a bazooka against deer would be appropriate, as long as it's in defense of his property and house.

I am not someone who thinks the Second Amendment should be repealed.

Quite the contrary, for 30 years I carried a firearm on my belt in connection with my employment, and have owned a number of guns.

But I do take exception to people who think it's okay to own assault weapons that fire 30 rounds in 30 seconds.

A survey of Creve Coeur, Ellisville, Ballwin, Town and Country and Maryland Heights shows they all have ordinances against firing BB guns, pellet guns and firearms within the city limits.

The Chesterfield proposal is clear. People fearing for their lives can shoot firearms to protect themselves and their houses from HUMANS—not squirrels, chipmunks and birds.

This is from a Post-Dispatch article by Mary Shapiro in 2012:

Former Chesterfield Ward 1 Councilman Gene Schenberg insists he has the constitutional right to use firearms or other weapons to protect his home from repeated invasions.

By squirrels.

But Schenberg's firing of pellet guns and darts to quell nuisance squirrels on his property has become a danger, said current Ward 1 Councilman Matt Segal, who defeated Schenberg for the council post three years ago.

Schenberg is not alone in taking up arms to control the tree rodents. Segal told his fellow council members of other instances in which Chesterfield residents have fired shotguns and .22 caliber rifles at squirrels.

"Do kids need to worry about bullets at their bus stops because a man is protecting his house from squirrels? Segal asked. "There are other ways to do that, such as traps. There's a loophole in our current laws, and it's our job to protect our citizens."

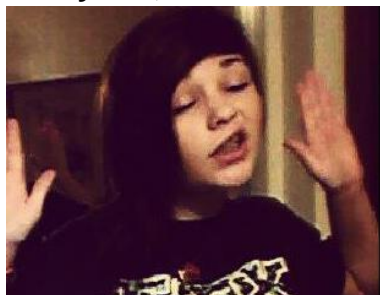

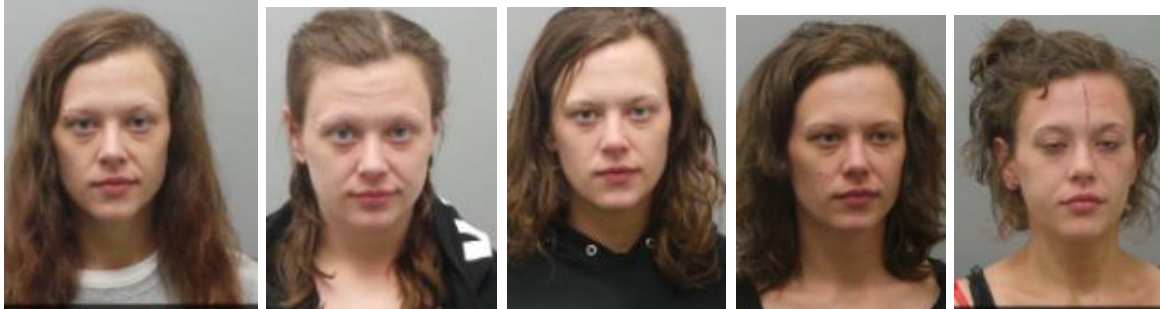

MONTHS AFTER SEARCH WARRANT FOUND LARGE AMOUNTS OF CHILD PORN AT 260 RIVER VALLEY DRIVE IN CHESTERFIELD THE HOMEOWNERS IS FINALLY CHARGED: The St. Louis County Police received a tip in 2019 from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children that computer activity showed child porn going to 260 River Valley Drive in Chesterfield, the home of 68-year-old William Murphy.



A search warrant was executed on September 10, 2019 and officers found several hundred pieces of child porn on computer devices.

Murphy was arrested on September 10, 2019 but was then released. He was not formally charged for a year-and-a-half on March 24, 2021.

The charging documents tell most of the story, but not “what took so long.”



Police obtain a search warrant for the Defendant's residence, which resulted in several devices being seized from the Defendant's residence. Forensic Analysis of the devices, specifically an Apple MacBook Pro, revealed 125 images of child erotica, 106 images of child pornography, 15 images of nude children, and 13 images of suspect.

Due to the nature of the offense, I believe the Defendant to be a danger to the community.

My only problem with this document is if the County Police believed Murphy to be a danger to the community, why did it take 18 months to file charges.

FORMER CHESTERFIELD COP HAS BEEN CHARGED AGAIN. THIS TIME FOR DRUGS AND FAILURE TO REGISTERED AS A SEX OFFENDER: In 2014 KTVI investigative reporter Chris Hayes broke the story of someone secretly recording men urinating at the men's restroom at the Mobil on the Run on Clarkson Road.

Hayes turned his information over to the Chesterfield Police where detectives did an investigation that showed Chesterfield Police Officer David Cerna while on-duty set up the camera and obtained videos from the camera. He shared some of the video online on websites.

A search warrant was obtained for Cerna's house in St. Charles, where officers found large amounts of videos of men's penises in restroom and more. They also found that Cerna had a glory hole at his house by the front door. He claimed on sex websites that he was a shy woman who wanted to perform oral sex on men but didn't want them to see "her."

He was arrested and charged in St. Louis County with felony sex and invasion of privacy charges. The same happened in St. Charles County. He was convicted in 2016 but was placed on probation instead of being sentenced to prison. He was forced to do 60-days in the St. Charles County Jail.

Cerna was back in jail, but pled guilty to both charges on March 26 and is now back on a probation term in lieu of a 4-year prison term.
