Red new building requested

Lutheran Service management is claiming the opposition and their website are providing false information

Nursing units being replace by senior living units. Opposition claims increase in traffic. Management claims there will be less traffic for families and care givers. Lutheran Services are claiming living units will reduced to 378 units from 432.

Opposition claims there will be an increase in EMS calls. Management points out the nursing unit producing far more EMS calls than fewer senior living units would cause.

Opposition claims Lutheran Services being a “non profit” the city would be cheated out of taxes. Lutheran services points out that Town and Country has no PROPERTY TAX, so the city will not be cheated out of any revenue. The county would not receive any tax income.



BULLSHIT FROM THE CITY The opposition is complaining about building over the city’s height requirement. The city also said they would replace trees cut down with more new trees.

The Mason Pointe’s spokesman said the nice thing about the suburbs is that there so many trees, cutting some down is no big deal.





