

My wife painted with Ralph Fournier for over 10 years after we returned to St. Louis. Ralph was a bomber pilot in WWII and was shot down after a mission toward the end of the war. He stayed in the Army as pilot after the end of the war, because he spoke French and flew out of Paris. He moved to St. Louis to attend Washington University after the war.





Ralph with some of his painting at a art show in Chesterfield Valley in He retired from designing houses by 1980 and began painting.

He quit driving in his 90s and my wife, Diana, would go to this house in Brentwood and pick him up and then go paint at the Art Guild. One day Ralph was at our house and seemed to have disappeared. He was in the front yard doing a watercolor painting of our house.

**IS THERE A BETTER PLACE TO DONATE MONEY?** Is the Military and first responders' statue really a needed item in Town and Country, when there is a very impressive military tribute call Jefferson Barracks in South County?

I'm actually a St. Louisan first and not a Town and Countryite. My father was an Army officer for all of WWII. He died in 2000 and is buried at Jefferson Barracks Cemetery.



At the end of the War my father was a major. My mother had been a high school teacher in Normandy, Mo. before marrying my father.

I have been to US Military cemetery in **Normandy France** where the memorial structures were not "rocks."

I have been to the **Gettysburg** war field and cemetery in Pennsylvania a number of times.

There were no "rocks" honoring the military but real statues.



In 1992 I took a group of fire chiefs from communist China touring the US, mostly seeing fire training centers and fire equipment, to Gettysburg. At the end of their tour they said Gettysburg was the most impressive site because they got to walk through President Eisenhower's modest house located next to the battle field. The comment was they would never see a former leader's house in China.

I have also spent time at Arlington cemetery with police escorts for funeral services of police officers who served in the military.

**Antietam Battlefield**. Every December an illumination of the ground would be held and traffic would wait on the shoulder of a two-lane highway to drive through. Again, there was no "rock."





Then there is the National Police Officers Memorial in Washinton, DC. There are sculptures but no no rocks.



Finally I got friendly with someone who fought in WWI and WWII. I don't think he would be big on spending six figures on a rock.

In between disc jockey shifts in 1969 and 1970 I would deliver prescriptions for the Shumate Drug Store on E. Lockwood in Webster Groves. All drug stores back in the day provided delivery service. One of the regular customers was Mrs. Andy High at 13 S. Maple located right behind the post office (now Schnarr's Hardware).



In 1974 I rented a carriage house several blocks down the street for 6-years when I was a police dispatcher in Creve Coeur and then a cop in Rock Hill. I would drive by the

house every day. Mrs. High had died and often I would see Andy High on the porch reading or listening to a Cardinal game on the radio. His eyesight was failing and he stopped driving.

Many people saw an old man walking down the street pulling a cart for his groceries, but Andy was unique and famous on several counts.

Andy was a major league baseball player for 12 years, including four years with the Cardinals when he moved into 13 S. Maple. He played in three World Series with the Cardinals including a championship year with a World Series ring in 1931.

Andy was only 5'6 and weighed about 160 earning him the nickname of "Handy Andy." He played third base and was a utility infielder with the Cardinals. At the end of his career on the diamond he had a lifetime .284 average.



Before playing professional baseball Andy had enlisted in the Navy during WWI. After his discharge he played minor league baseball for two years when he joined the Brooklyn Dodgers playing in every game in the 1922 season.

After the 1934 season with the Cincinnati Reds, he retired and became a minor league manager for the Dodgers and by 1940 he was a scout.

One year after the outbreak of WWII, High was in his mid-40s and reenlisted in the Navy. He was a chief petty officer with a Seabee unit building temporary airfields in the Pacific for fighters and bombers.

After the war he continued to live in Webster Groves and scouted for the Dodgers. In 1950 he was named "chief scout" of the Dodgers. He continued working for the Dodgers several years after their move to LA before retiring.

For several years when I would be coming home from my police job and if Andy was on

his porch I'd stop and we would talk baseball.

I was so impressed with Andy's war record and his baseball career, that I went to Sandy McMillan, co-owner of Rolling Ridge Nursey and a Webster city councilman. We were able to get the small baseball field on S. Elm and Glendale Road named "Andy High Field." For the local guy who fought in two world wars it honored him with a name plate on a backstop that said "Andy High Field" which is much nicer than a rock. He had a huge smile on his face at the ceremony.

Andy was a big fan of Bob Costas, who lived in nearby Shrewsbury. In 1980 I had written a feature article on Bob for St. Louis Magazine. I called him several times asking him to drop by and say hi to Andy. He agreed but before he could Andy had a stroke. Bob did visit him in the hospital. Andy never returned to South Maple. His son in Ohio moved him there to be close to the family. He died a year later. But his house is still on South Maple unchanged by any developer.

Per Andy's wished his body came back to St. Louis for burial.

**WHY?** The reason I spent all this time talking about the "rock" and actual statues?

Raising all this money for a rock seems to be a bit much. I know of a Town and Country Officer forced to retire due to a back injury after being rear ended on I-64, but none that died on duty. Same for the fire service.

People who need donations are not with Mayor Rehm and Ald Sue Allen's pet project. Why not try **Disabled American Veterans**, Children's Hospital, the Salvation Army or the Human Society instead of six figures for a rock?






