NARRATIVE

On 03-30-2014 at 0118 hours I was dispatched to Harpo's Bar and Grill at 134 Hilltown Village Ctr in reference to a fight in progress.

Lieutenant Dunn 196 was first on scene. Lt. Dunn stated as he arrived he observed a large group of people on the patio and walkway of Harpo's. The crowd was shoving and fighting back and forth. As he approached and attempted to separate the crowd he observed a female laying on her back who appeared to be unconscious. The female was surrounded by individuals attempting to assist her.

As Lt. Dunn continued to separate the crowd he noticed a younger white male being dragged away from the crowd by an older white male. The younger male, later identified as suspect Theodore Federer, was attempting to pull away from the older male and return to fight the crowd. The older male eventually gained control of Federer and was attempting to get him in his vehicle and leave the scene. Lt. Dunn ordered both individuals and vehicle to not leave the scene. Lt. Dunn obtained his drivers license which identified him as Ted Federer with a birth date of [REDACTED]. He identified the younger male he was restraining as his son. After running the vehicle's license plate through DOR it came back registered to [REDACTED], [REDACTED]. Lt. Dunn was told by the bouncer, [REDACTED], that Federer was involved in the fight.

As I arrived on scene I observed a large crowd of people gathered on the patio and the adjacent parking lot. I began to gather witness statements from members of the crowd while EMS was enroute. As I was talking to members of the crowd, I observed a white male, later identified as Theodore Federer, in blue jeans and a ripped blue t shirt running from the scene. He was heading South across the Schnucks' parking lot. Myself and PO Saffa 296 initiated a foot pursuit after Federer. As I was running I repeatedly yelled to Federer "Police, stop running", but he continued to flee. I observed Federer appear to enter the Schnucks, and myself and PO Saffa entered the business to search for him while other officers canvassed the area. Federer was located a few moments later hiding behind some concrete pillars at Sheridan's Frozen Custard located at 155 Hilltown Village Center. He attempted to flee again from PO Martin and Smajlovic, but stopped running when his direction of travel was cut off by PO Ghassemi 144. Federer was taken into custody by PO Martin 266 and PO Smajlovic 268 without any use of force.

As PO Martin searched Federer he discovered a bag of 11 small blue pills, believed to be Xanax. These pills were seized as evidence and will be sent to the St. Louis County Crime Lab for analysis. Federer stated the pants he was wearing were not his.

PO Carter 291 and Lt Dunn spoke with one of the bartender's who believed he saw Federer punch the victim, later identified as [REDACTED], in the face. The bartender, [REDACTED], was placed in PO Carter's patrol vehicle and was driven past Federer to do an identification on him. Miles positively identified Federer as the man he saw punch [REDACTED] in the face. [REDACTED] stated he was inside Harpo's behind the bar when the fight began to break out outside. He stated he ran outside where he saw Federer punching multiple people, and then saw Federer punch [REDACTED] in the face, knocking her to the ground.

I spoke with Harpo's employee and door guard, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated he was inside and attempting to get all of the customers outside of Harpo's so they could close down. After he got most of the people outside he began to turn around to go back inside when he heard the crowd becoming restless. He observed the crowd begin to push each other and saw several people begin to fight several other people. He began to attempt to break up the crowd when he observed [REDACTED] lying on the ground on her back. Lewis was unsure of who struck [REDACTED], as he was attempting to break up the crowd.

[REDACTED] was transported by Monarch Fire Protection District Ambulance to St. Luke's Hospital for full medical evaluation. PO Ghassemi 144 followed the Ambulance to the Hospital to take photographs of [REDACTED]'s injuries. PO Ghassemi observed [REDACTED] to have a large bruise just above the elbow on her right arm. [REDACTED] also had a large lump on her forehead, approximately the size of a golf ball, just slightly left of the center of her forehead that was beginning to turn blue. PO Ghassemi will submit these photos into evidence along with [REDACTED]'s written victim statement, and supplement this report. [REDACTED] was evaluated by Dr. Martin at St. Lukes, and it is unknown at this time if she was admitted as they were still running medical tests prior to PO Ghassemi's departure.

PO Martin transported Federer to the Chesterfield Police Department to assist me in booking. Throughout the entire booking process Federer was uncooperative, making threats to PO Martin and myself. Federer used much profanity, He further stated he "had a million dollars in the bank" and that "karma was gonna hit us hard". Federer made multiple statements suggesting if a wife, girlfriend, or family member died we would have it coming to us.

The bag of blue pills was placed on the counter approximately one foot away from the small port hole to the holding cell. As PO Martin and I were setting up the LiveScan fingerprint machine, Federer was observed by Lt Dunn and records clerk [REDACTED] on the booking room observation camera at approximately 0212 hours reaching through the port hole and grabbing the bag of pills. They immediately phoned the booking room and informed me of the situation. I looked to the counter and observed the bag of pills was missing, and quickly entered the holding cell and observed Federer holding the bag of pills down by his groin area and attempting to open the bag. I ordered Federer to drop the bag, and he complied. I searched Federer to be sure he had not placed the pills anywhere on his person. I recovered the bag to find it partially open at one end, but none of the pills appeared to be missing.

Federer has been charged with [REDACTED] Possession of a Controlled Substance, and [REDACTED]. He was also [REDACTED] by [REDACTED]. Federer was transported to

St. Louis County Intake Center by PO Martin and Smajlovic to be held pending application of warrants, and awaiting pickup by [REDACTED] Sheriff's department. It should be noted I will be requesting copies of the booking room footage, and in car camera footage from Federer's transport to St. Louis County to enter into evidence.

NARRATIVE

On 07-18-2014 at 0630 hours, I received a copy of the controlled substance analysis report from the St. Louis County Crime Laboratory regarding the pills found in the possession of suspect Theodore Federer.

The pills in question were analyzed and determined to be 1 milligram each of Alprazolam (Xanax), with a Missouri Controlled Substance Schedule of 4.

A copy of the Crime Laboratory Analysis Report has been entered into evidence.

NARRATIVE

The purpose of this report is to address discrepancies from the original report and previous supplemental reports.

The bartender witness, [REDACTED], who believed he identified suspect, Theodore Federer, punch victim, [REDACTED] in the face was later discovered to be intoxicated. [REDACTED]' witness statement did not match the evidence found on the surveillance footage from Harpo's Bar and Grill that was obtained at a later date.

Detective Murphy 253 retrieved surveillance footage of the fight in question from Harpo's Bar and Grill, and entered a copy of this footage into evidence. Upon viewing this footage it was clear Federer was not the individual who punched [REDACTED] in the face. It was discovered Federer punched an unknown male in the back of the head, and this unknown male then attempted to punch another unknown male who ducked, causing the first unknown male to strike [REDACTED] in the face. No information was able to be discovered about the unknown male who punched [REDACTED], as he was unidentifiable in the footage, and no witnesses accounted for him.

PO Ghassemi 144 went to St. Lukes Hospital after the fight to photograph [REDACTED]'s injuries and to attempt to obtain a victim statement. After photographing [REDACTED] PO Ghassemi attempted to obtain a statement from her, but [REDACTED] refused to cooperate stating she did not wish to press charges and did not know who punched her.

The St. Louis County Prosecuting Attorney has issued the charge of Possession of a Controlled Substance against Federer. They refused to issue the charges of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Evidence due to a lack of evidence for those charges.

NARRATIVE

On today's date at 1500 hours, I responded to the St. Louis County Prosecuting Attorney's Office to sign a Probable Cause statement.

Suspect Theodore Federer has been charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance, a Class C felony.
