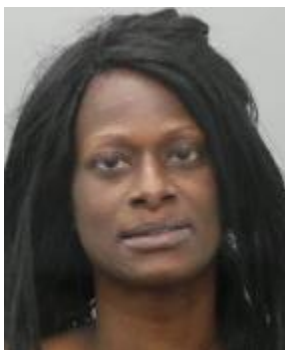

The next day we went to Principia College campus for a view high above the Mississippi River. On their last night in town I took them to the place that was most like an English Pub, O'Connell's at Kingshighway and Shaw. During dinner I promised to take them to see some of the big houses on Lindell Blvd and in Clayton and U-City. They stopped me and said they'd rather if I could take them back Ted Drewes. That is what we did, two out of three days we were at Ted Drewes.

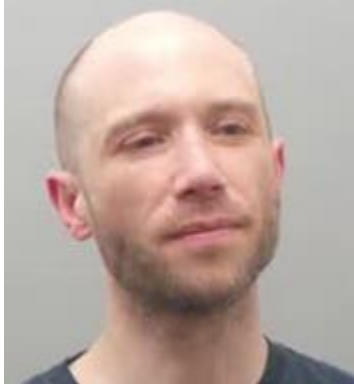

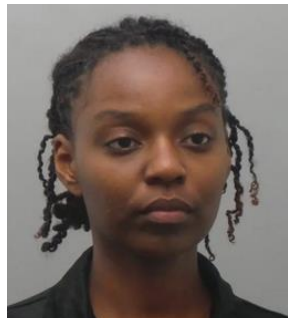

## CHESTERFIELD CITY COUNCIL MEETING Tuesday September 3, 2024



### **COUNCILMAN DAN HURT VOTES AGAINST THE DOWNTOWN BUSINESS**

**DISTRICT TAX STATUS** This resolution didn't finalize making a Downtown Business District (Redevelopment and replacement of Chesterfield Mall with a special property tax to pay for increases in city service the development will require). This resolution is only the first step in establishing the special property tax.

Councilwoman Merrell Hansen said that the developers promised their backing of the Downtown Business District. Councilman Dan Hurt immediately said that no promises were made. Councilwoman Barb McGuinness then spoke up backing Councilwoman Hansen saying the promises were made at neighborhood association meetings.

A voice vote was then taken and passed 7-1 with Hurt voting against the resolution. Maybe he wants the all the city's homeowners to have to pay for increased services and not the residential and retail owners in the new development or he hates new taxes. This is how the money would be spent:

A. Maintenance, repair, and replacement of streets, street lighting, bike paths, and pedestrian pathways;

B. Maintenance, repair, and replacement of landscaped center medians within City accepted streets, including irrigation (to the extent they are separable from systems serving other areas not to be maintained by the City);

C. Security; Police

D. Maintenance, repair and replacement of the public parking garage

E. Maintenance, repair and replacement of the public park including programming for marketing and events;

F. Legal, insurance, administration, and financial oversight; and

G. All other qualified and allowable expenditures of any other special district located within the City, established in accordance with the Special District Act.

Word is Hurt wants to run for Mayor in the April elections. Apparently voting NO on taxes even if it is just a Staenberg Group development that will be impacted is a good move.

This was a debated issue in the pre-meeting agenda review meeting.

**NEW POLICE EQUIPMENT THANKS TO A 2016 CASE:** Chesterfield had a police officer assigned to a Federal Criminal Task Force that resulted in a 2016 criminal case. The case was just adjudicated eight years later and money seized was forfeited and in 2024 distributed to agencies involved. Here is an explanation from Chief Funkhouser:

The funds came from a federal partnership group that we used to have an officer detached to many years ago. In fact, if I remember correctly, these funds came from a 2016 case that was just recently adjudicated and the funds divided amongst the partnering agencies.

One Training

Two Replace a Utility Task Vehicle use to patrol levee

Three Replace two fleet vehicles totaled in crashes

Four Purchase and install in-car video unit

**MEETING CHANGE:** The next meeting was originally scheduled for an unusual Wednesday night date on September 18, The Council voted to move it back one day to Tuesday September 17.

**MAYOR ELECTION RUMORS CONTINUE.** The rumor swirl still has Councilman Dan Hurt planning to run for mayor in the April 2025 election. A number of people are reportedly pushing Councilwoman Merrell Hansen to file.
