Police say Lawrence P. Cushshon, 37, shot and killed Rahkim Scott, 22, outside an apartment on Grand Boulevard near 20th Street on April 20. Cushshon opened fire with an assault-style rifle after Scott got in an SUV and began backing out of the parking space, according to court documents.

Scott was hit at least 15 times, the court documents say. He was pronounced dead at the scene.

**Cushshon was charged with murder** and armed criminal action. He was held in lieu of \$200,000 cash-only bail.

The shooting occurred about 3:45 p.m. in an apartment parking lot along Grand Boulevard, police said. Scott was found dead in the driver's seat of a silver BMW SUV.

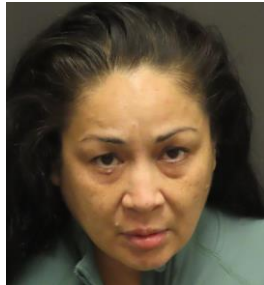

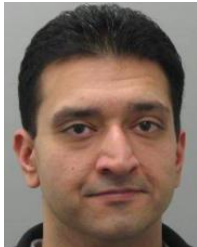

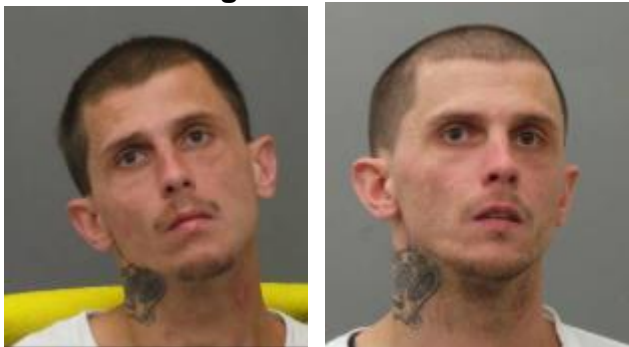

**CITY COUNCIL THROWS PUBLIC SAFETY OUT THE WINDOW AND REAPPOINTS THE MOST DANGEROUS MAN IN CHESTERFIELD AS PROSECUTING ATTORNEY:**

We thought it was wrong for this City Council to reappoint Tim Engelmeyer as the City's prosecuting attorney since his 4-year term doesn't expire until June. That should be the job of the newly elected mayor (to place a person for appointment) and the new City Council for appointment.

We have documented over the years how people charged with DWI, serious moving violation and stealing will get charges reduced to lesser or non-criminal charges if they hire a defense attorney.

DWI and stealing are graduated felonies meaning after three convictions the next one is a felony. That is not likely to happen as Engelmeyer reduces charges of repeat offenders if they have a defense attorney. He places people who are highly intoxicated and/or involved in crashes when drunk on SIS (no record, no fine, no-points) probation if they show up with a lawyer. Serious moving violations are reduced to \$200 and \$300 parking tickets. Stealing cases where a defense lawyer is involved are reduced to "littering" or other non-criminal offenses with high fines. Retail outlets are the source for most of Chesterfield's revenue, but Engelmeyer ignores the keeping thieves away by tough prosecution as long as fellow lawyers are making some money.

The long concrete barriers blocking shoulders on Long Road and Clarkson Road are a hot issue. Both speakers running for the Council in April, spoke about how upset residents are about the blockage of the shoulders.

Michele Olney brought up the safety issue if police, ambulances and fire trucks are on emergencies, the bump outs keep motorist from getting out of the way of emergency vehicles and make it impossible for the emergency vehicles to use the shoulder when necessary.

The mayor remarked that the streets are State Roads so the city has no direct input. However, he mentioned the heavy amount of citizen comments to City Hall against the Bump Out. The mayor stated he has spoken to several MoDOT officials reference the Bump Outs.



**COUNCILWOMAN BARB MCGUINNESS SAVES THE CITY \$7,200.** The Council had a budget amendment to fund additional \$19,020 to the \$84,299 to print and mail quarterly the City newsletters. This includes a \$19,020 addition funding due to an increase in cost. The newsletter for 2025 for the first time would include a “pullout” section. McGuinness’ amendment would eliminate the pullout section saving \$7,200 dollars.

Councilwoman Maryann Mastorakos spoke in favor of the pullout. She and Councilman Mike Moore voted against the amendment, apparently in favor of pissing away \$7,200.

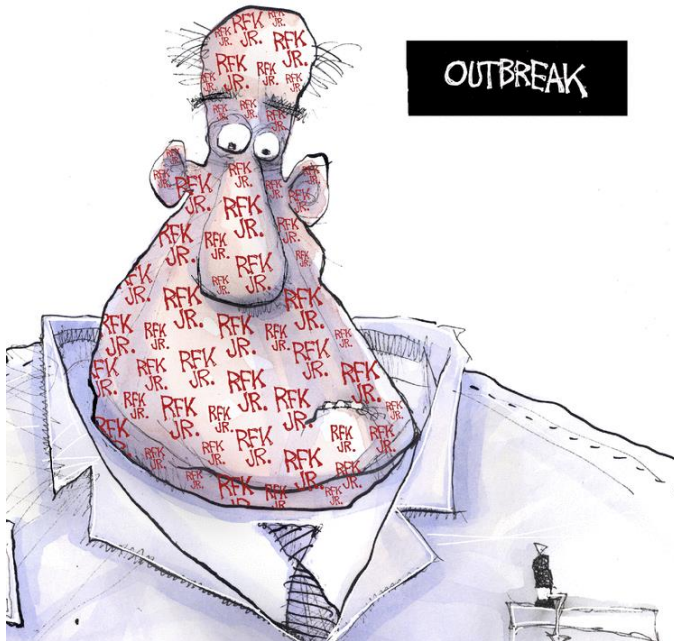
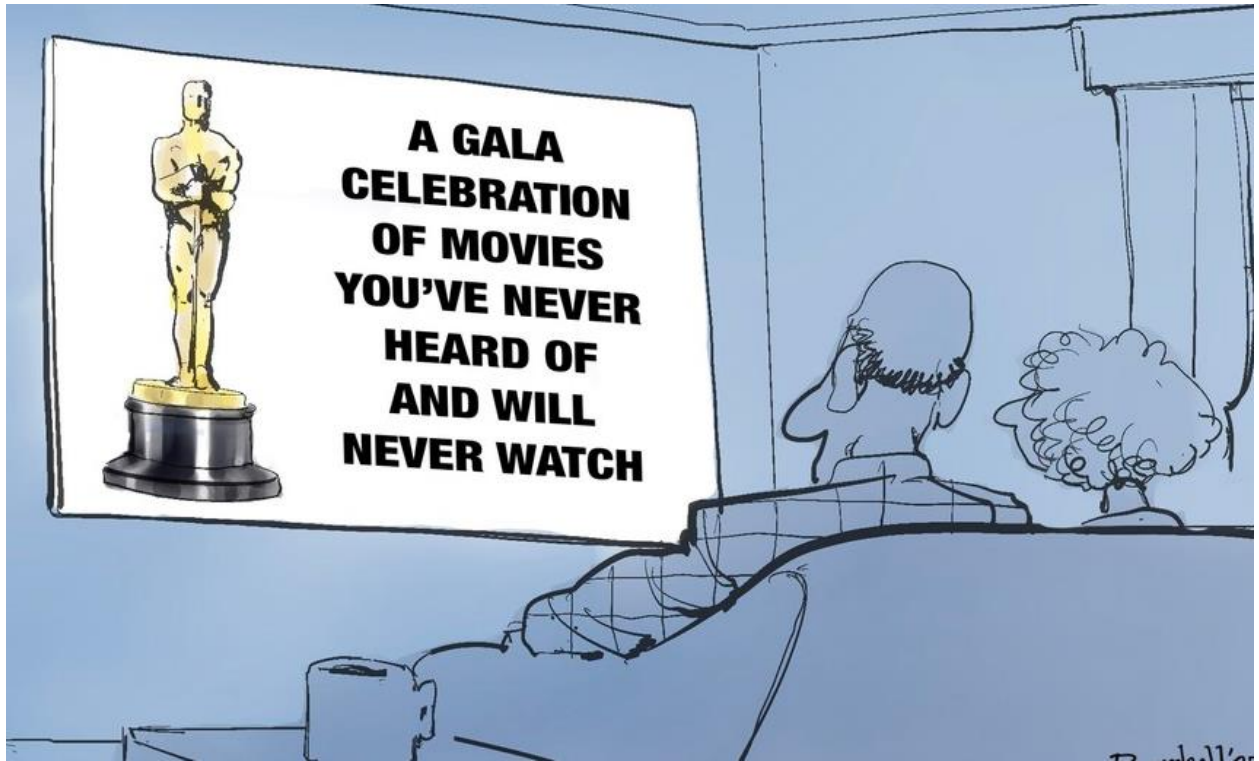

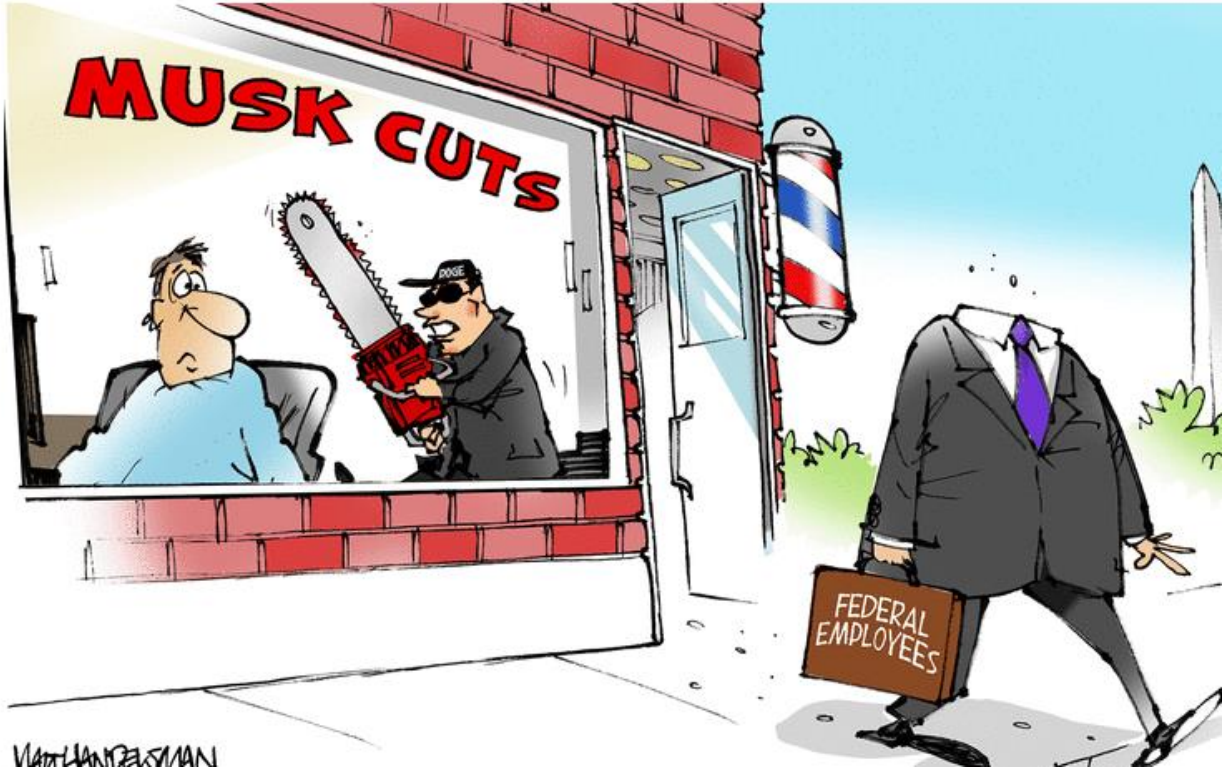
