**TUNNEL UNDER CLAYTON ROAD TO TOWN SQUARE GETTING SOME ART:**

The City plans to allocate \$11,250 in the partnership with the Principia High School to create and install murals in the pedestrian tunnel from the sidewalk on the north side of Clayton Road to the Town Square.

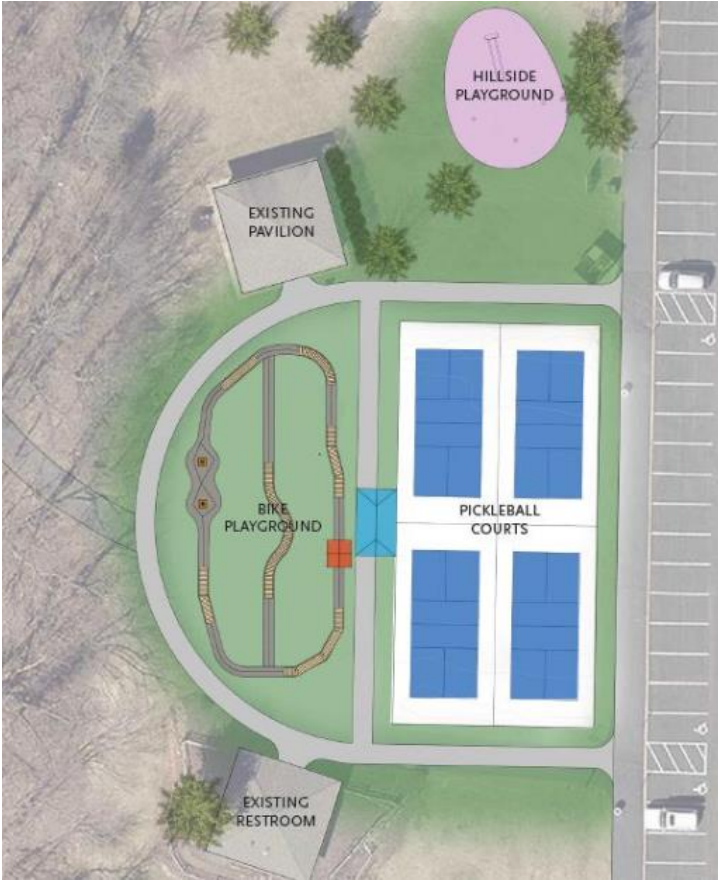




This looks very nice, however, it would be nice to know how many people in a month use this tunnel before spending \$11,250 (after the residents got hit with the first real estate tax in 25 years). Ald. Harder agreed with me and wanted the murals placed where more people could see them. The measure passed 7-1 with Harder voting NO.

**MUNICIPAL PARKS GRANT OF \$465,000 TO BE USED FOR PICKLEBALL COURTS AND BIKE PLAYGROUND.**

The Alderpersons approved spending \$17,200 to go with a \$465,000 Grant to build four pickleball courts and a bicycle playground in Preservation Park.



This will not affect the existing tennis courts which are south of the planned pickleball courts. This was first read and will be voted on in April.

I have mentioned this before...the bike playground could result in injury liability issues for the city and an increase in EMS calls. I just think kids should fall off their bikes and get hurt off city property.

Of course during this time there was no enforcement action. One would think the city staff would note that the license was expired and have the police cite Mineo's and shut down the sale of booze.

On Monday night the liquor license that expired on June 30, 2024 was renewed.

John Mineo Senior has been dead for several years. His son, John Mineo, Jr. is an ex-convicted felon having served time for a real estate scam and cannot hold a liquor license. The license is under the name of Ardian Hoxhaj, a college student at SLU.

**Clarkson Rd (US Bank \*ATM)-** While servicing the drive- thru ATM at US Bank. The technician was approached by 2 masked individuals and shoved backwards by them. They then took trays of cash from the opened ATM and fled the area in a waiting vehicle. The victim was uninjured.

ENDANGERMENT**

**Clarkson and Baxter -** An officer on patrol observed a vehicle violate the electric signal for southbound Clarkson at Baxter. The officer activated his emergency lights, and the vehicle was slow to stop. Upon contact with the driver, she showed obvious signs of impairment as well as the smell of an alcoholic beverage as she spoke. Subsequent investigation led to her arrest for DWI. While being placed in the patrol vehicle for transport, she began crying and said there was a 5-month-old baby home alone at their residence in Wildwood. Officers contacted the Wildwood precinct for the child endangerment investigation, as well as the subject's wife who responded home from work. The subject submitted to a breath test at 0137 hours with a result of .142% BAC (over 1 ½ hours after the original stop). She was placed in a cell for a sobering period after processing. It should be noted the baby was found safe, and Wildwood will be pursuing child endangerment charges against both mothers.

**STOLEN VEHICLES (MULTIPLE CASES)**

Chesterfield Detectives worked with Saint Louis City and Saint Louis County Detectives to execute a search warrant on two locations involving an identified suspect. Detectives located two key fobs that match the property taken during vehicle break-ins and vehicle thefts. The suspect was taken into custody by Saint Louis County Detectives and placed under arrest for Murder 1st charges. Chesterfield Detectives will interview the suspect at a later date. A second suspect identified in these thefts is cooperating with Saint Louis County Detectives.

An adult subject disseminating private sexual images taken with an ex-girlfriend was arrested after it was discovered he was also sending them to a juvenile.
