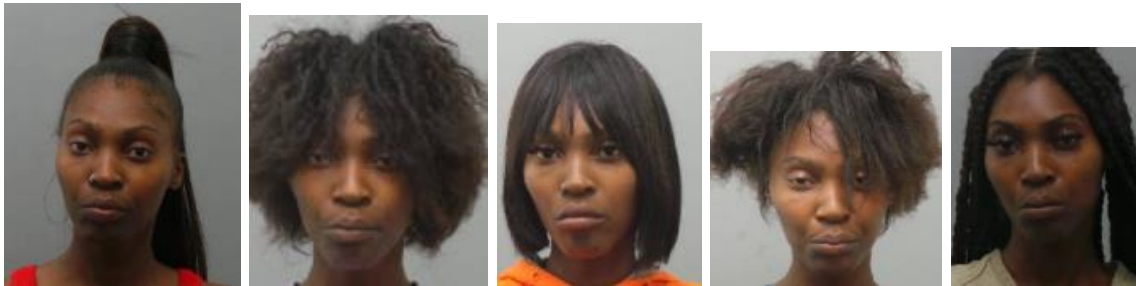

CHESTERFIELD MAN CHARGED WITH SEXUALLY ASSAULTING TWO 14-YEAR-OLD GIRLS FROM ST. CHARLES AT HIS CHESTERFIELD HOME: Mykola Sarnytsky, 25, on Thursday April 3 picked up two 14-year-old in St, Charles and took them to his house at 60 Conway Cove, where he sexually assaulted them.

That Mykola Sarnytsky, in violation of Section 566.071, RSMo, committed the class E felony of child molestation in the fourth degree punishable upon conviction under Sections 566.071, 558.011 and 558.002, RSMo, in that on or about on or about April 3, 2025, in the County of St. Louis, State of Missouri, the defendant, being more than 4 years older than AV knowingly subjected AV who was less than 17 years old to sexual contact by engaging in intercourse.

COUNT: 03 STATUTORY SODOMY OR ATTEMPTED STATUTORY SODOMY - DEVIATE SEXUAL INTERCOURSE - PERSON LESS THAN 14 YOA - CLASS U FELONY

That Mykola Sarnytsky, in violation of Section 566.062, RSMo, committed the felony of statutory sodomy in the first degree, punishable upon conviction under Section 566.062, RSMo, and subject to lifetime supervision under Sections 217.735 and 559.106, RSMo, in that on or about on or about April 3, 2025, in the County of St. Louis, State of Missouri, the defendant had deviate sexual intercourse with RB who was then a child less fourteen years old, by engaging in oral sex upon the defendant.

I, Chris Muench, DSN 5278, Chesterfield Police Department, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true and documented in report number 25-1384. I have probable cause to believe that on April 3, 2025, within St. Louis County, Mykola Sarnytsky, White, Male, 5'09", 205lbs, committed one or more criminal offenses.

Count: 01 SODOMY OR ATTEMPTED SODOMY - 1ST DEGREE - CLASS U FELONY

Count: 02 CHILD MOLESTATION - 4TH DEGREE - CHILD LESS THAN 17 YOA AND OFFENDER GREATER THAN 4 YEARS OLDER - CLASS E FELONY

Count: 03 STATUTORY SODOMY OR ATTEMPTED STATUTORY SODOMY - DEVIATE SEXUAL INTERCOURSE - PERSON LESS THAN 14 YOA - CLASS U FELONY

The facts supporting this belief are as follows: Defendant drove to the home of victim A.V. where he picked up both victim A.V. and victim R.B. The three drove to the home of the defendant located in Chesterfield Mo. Once at the home the defendant engaged in oral and vaginal sex with victim A.V. , a 14 yr. old female. The defendant also engaged in oral sex with victim R.B. a female child less than 14 yrs. The police were alerted to possible illegal activity taking place at the defendants home. When the police arrived to inquire the defendant ran out of the home. The defendant was taken into custody The defendant made some admissions. Both victim were transported to the hospital for evaluations.

I believe that the defendant poses a danger to a crime victim because of the nature of the charges and the ages of the victims.

On 04/03/2025, Officers with the Chesterfield Police Department investigated a call for a missing juvenile from St. Charles Co., and it was believed that the juvenile may be at an address on Conway Cove in Chesterfield.

Upon arrival, while one officer knocked on the front door, an assist officer observed several individuals exit from the rear of the home but were immediately located and detained for this investigation.

During this investigation, the reported missing juvenile (female) was located, along with another female juvenile, who disclosed that they were brought to that address by an adult male they met online from an app called HILY.

The juvenile victims disclosed that MYKOLA SARNYTSKY picked them up in St. Charles, where they met him near the home of one of the juvenile victims. The victims advised they knew he was an adult, and he knew that they were both underage prior to having sexual contact with each underage victim.

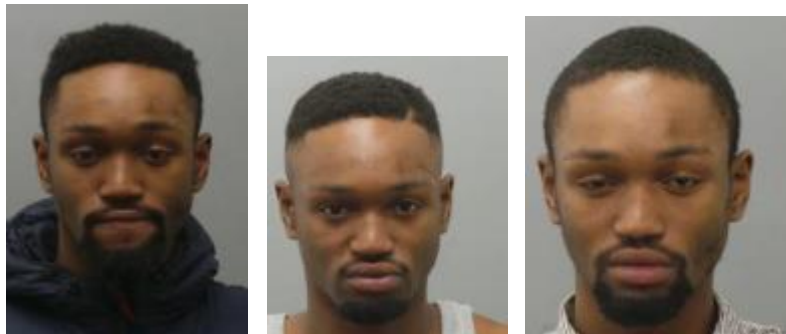

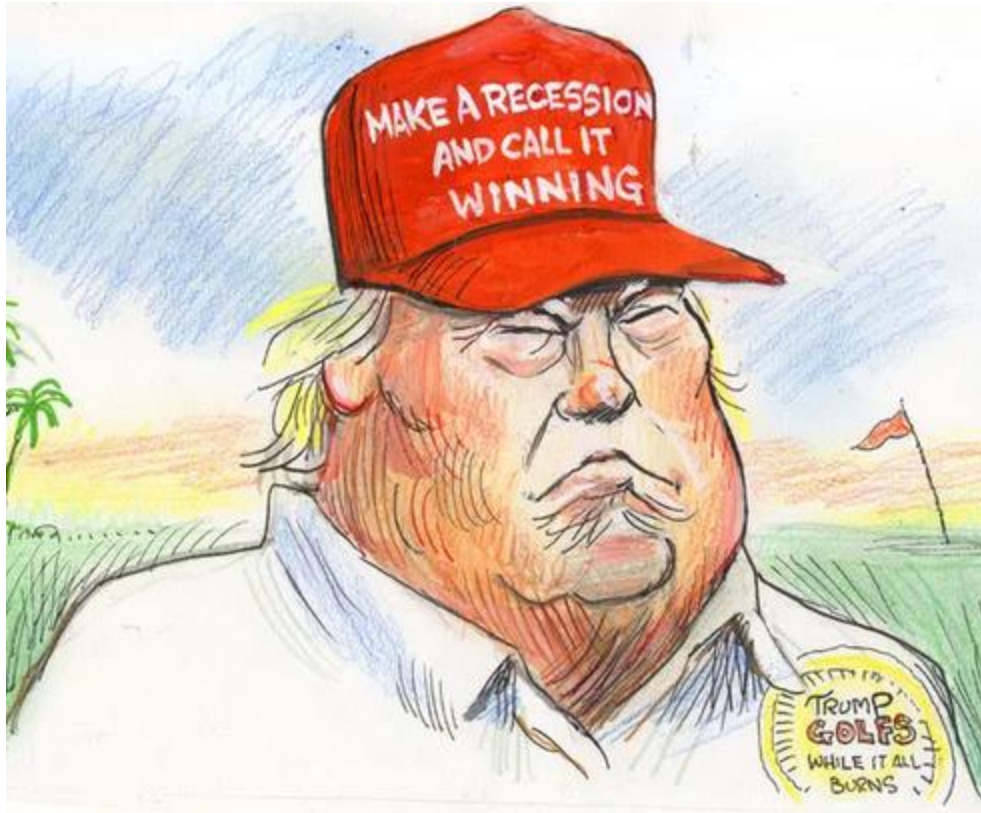
