In regard to the proposed "multi-use pedestrian facility" proposed construction planned for Mason Road, we wish to express our opinion on the practicality of the project. We feel both the plan and scope of the project are unnecessary and without value. The project will only improve the walkway cosmetically and not provide an additional functionality. It will, in fact, eliminate a significant amount of existing green space. We are opposed to the implementation of the project and feel the City would be better served if the sidewalk were repaired and left in its present dimensions without change. Additional signage would then become unnecessary nor would there be a need to construct the crosswalk on Mason Road. The tax payer funds saved by this alternative approach could then be applied to more important needs in the City of Town and County. To be clear, we intend to strongly oppose the construction of the "multi-use pedestrian facility" on Mason Road.
