Offense / Incident Narrative

Sir,

On Tuesday, 04.29.2014, at approximately 0015hrs., I responded to the area of 1800 S. McKnight Rd. for a motor vehicle crash with injuries. While en route to the scene, dispatch advised that there was some kind of disturbance between the subjects involved in the crash.

Upon arrival, I could see that a grey colored, 2001 Toyota Tundra, bearing MO 2014 temporary registration 00A5DA, and a black colored Bentley GT, bearing MO 2014 registration KJ7Y6Y, had collided near the center dividing line for north and south bound traffic on McKnight Rd. causing the roadway to be closed down. There were several people walking around the crash, one man being the driver of the Bentley who was identified as:

It should be noted, that Mr. Rosenblum goes by the name Scott.

I contacted Officer Craig Eisenbeis, DSN 125, who investigated the crash. Officer Eisenbeis stated that it appeared the Bentley was traveling south bound on McKnight Rd. before it crossed over into the north bound lane and struck the curb. He showed me the area where the contact was made with the curb and I could see that a mud puddle had splashed in a southern direction in the north bound lane indicating that the vehicle that went through the puddle had been traveling south bound. There was also a wet tire track curving from the south bound lane, into the north bound lane and then into the puddle.

The Bentley had come to a rest pointing in a southwestern direction, which indicated that it was traveling from the area of the mud puddle.

I would later respond to the scene of the crash again and examine the gouge and skid marks. I was unable to get the skid marks to photograph given the dark lighting, however it was clear that the front left tire on Scott's vehicle had left a skid mark on the roadway leading up to the area of impact. The distance from the initial point of impact on the curb to the point of impact was 112 feet and 11 inches. Based on the evidence at the scene, it was very apparent that Scott's vehicle had been traveling south bound and crossed completely into the north bound lane, onto the shoulder, struck the curb, and then turned back towards the south bound lane at which time the crash occurred. The area of impact was clearly visible from the gouge marks left in the roadway and vehicle fluid that was splattered on the pavement in a southwestern direction.

For complete details surrounding the crash portion of this incident, please see Officer Eisenbeis' attached crash report.

I contacted the driver of the pickup in the back of the ambulance, and he was identified as:

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Ronald had small cuts all over his face and hands, several abrasions on his face, a knot in the middle of his forehead and a bloody nose. I asked Ronald what happened and he started crying asking me why the other driver was in the wrong lane of traffic. He followed that by saying that he'd just purchased his truck and hadn't even made the first payment on it yet. Ronald explained that he'd been traveling north bound when the other vehicle came into his lane and struck his vehicle.

I asked Ronald how much he'd had to drink that night and he stated he'd had a single, 16 ounce bottle of Budweiser brand beer at Busch Stadium earlier in the night. I asked if he felt that he was intoxicated and he answered "No." I asked Ronald to submit to standardized field sobriety testing (S.F.S.T.'s) and he stated he would take the test. It should be noted, that I only administered the horizontal gaze nystagmus test as Ronald had already been strapped to the gurney.

I explained that he was to follow the stimulus (my right index finger) with his eyes only, while holding his head still. Ronald stated he understood and we began the test. Ronald's eyes tracked equally, his pupils were of equal size and he did not exhibit resting nystagmus. Ronald had smooth pursuit in both eyes, he did not have distinct and sustained nystagmus in either eye and did not exhibit the onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees with some white showing in either eye. Ronald's pupils did not appear dilated, and he stated that he didn't feel light headed. It didn't appear to me that Ronald was impaired at the time.

I asked Ronald to voluntarily consent to a chemical test of his blood and he agreed to do so. Ronald was later transported to Mercy Hospital in Creve Coeur, Missouri for a medical evaluation as well as a voluntary blood draw. It should be noted, that it was learned that the test conducted on Ronald's blood by hospital staff showed his blood was, "negative for alcohol." At the time of this narrative, the conclusive results from the samples Ronald voluntarily provided for this department are not available. When I receive those findings, I will add that information in supplemental form.

I located Scott, who was standing in the driveway of 1800 S. McKnight Rd. Scott's balance was visibly poor, and his gait was unsteady as he walked as well. I contacted him and immediately could detect the strong odor of intoxicants on his breath. I also noted that his eyes were red and watery, his eye lids were droopy and his speech was deliberate, slurred, mumbled and confused at times as he repeatedly asked who called the media and would ask when they were going to be there.

I asked Scott to submit to S.F.S.T.'s but Scott told me he wasn't going to take those tests. Scott stated that he'd been working 16 hour days recently for a big case that he'd won that day which was why he appeared so tired. It should be noted, that while in close quarters with Scott, I could detect

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the strong odor of intoxicants on his breath and it was very evident that he was struggling to maintain his balance as he stood.

Ultimately, I advised Scott that he was under arrest and asked him to put his hands behind his back for handcuffing. Scott told me that I wasn't going to put hand cuffs on him. I explained that it was how people were placed under arrest and after a short debate about it, Scott was secured in handcuffs, which were checked for proper fit and double-locked for everyone's safety. He was seated in the rear of patrol car 31 where he was transported to the Brentwood P.D.

While en route to the B.P.D., Scott advised me several times that he was just tired from working so many hours, however it should be noted that the odor of intoxicants was strong enough in the car that I was able to detect it while driving.

Upon arrival at the B.P.D., I secured Scott's personal effects and seated him in the interview room of the jail. Scott was found to have \$1,140.00 in folding money on his person at the time of the arrest. He later posted a \$500.00 bond, that was set by the Honorable Judge Ronald Hill, using that money.

At approximately 0103hrs., I advised Scott of his constitutional rights per the Miranda Warning, and he stated he understood his rights. I then advised him of Missouri Implied Consent, asking for breath and blood samples, however Scott stated he would not take the tests. Scott declined to answer any questions related to the alcohol influence report.

Throughout the booking process, Scott commented that he'd only had one drink, and later asked me to estimate his blood alcohol concentration (B.A.C.). When I refused, he asked me if I believed he looked drunk and I told him that I believed that he was impaired. He was insistent about me noting in the report that he was working very long hours due to the court case that he was working.

Scott had several abrasions on his face. He was asked if he wanted medical attention, however he declined.

At one point, Scott questioned what probable cause I had to arrest him for driving while intoxicated. I explained that it was the totality of the circumstances surrounding this incident ranging from the crash to his obvious impaired state. He then asked me again to estimate what his B.A.C. was. I told him that I had no way to guess that but just advised him that he was obviously impaired.

Scott continued to ask throughout the booking process who called the media and if there were at the B.P.D. Despite being told numerous times that no one from our office called the media and that they

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weren't on the property, Scott was still confused.

Scott was booked, photographed, finger printed, cited for driving while intoxicated and careless and imprudent driving, and posted his \$500.00 bond before being released on summons. The summons', Driving While Intoxicated #120679546 and Careless and Imprudent Driving #120679547 have a return date of June 9, 2014 at 1900 hours in the Brentwood Municipal Court. He was later provided with a copy of the revocation/suspension form (2385) at his residence because it was left at the Brentwood Police Department the night he was released.

It should be noted that at 0230hrs., Officer Todd Lambert, DSN 146, responded to Mercy Hospital in Creve Coeur, Missouri, to retrieve a voluntary blood draw from Ronald. Ronald voluntarily consented to provide his blood for the purpose of testing for alcohol. Ronald voluntarily signed a Brentwood permission to search form, which was later packaged and placed into this department's temporary evidence locker. A copy of the permission to search form was also digitally scanned into this report. Officer Lambert was also provided with a blood collection request form via Mercy Hospital Public Safety Officer #51. The sample was drawn at 0318hrs., on the date of this incident by James Vancil, a Lab Medical Tech Assistant. Officer Lambert then conveyed the blood sample to the station, where it was properly packaged and entered as evidence. It will be conveyed to the lab for processing at a later date.

I was later able to review the video from the interview room where Scott was held while we prepared the paperwork. While he was left in the interview room, Scott made several statements to himself. The following is what was said by Scott during that time. It should be noted that not all the statements made were clear enough to be understood due to a heavy slur. The times marked next to each statement correlate to the time on the video surveillance system.

1:02:42 - I just fucked up my career.
1:05:18 - I fucked up.
1:05:30 - I'm not that drunk.
1:05:33 - (Inaudible)
1:06:32 - I understand my responsibility.
1:06:39 - Goes with the turf.
1:06:40 - Screwed up got a D.W.I.
1:06:53 - You know what...it's a blessing.
1:07:01 - Nothing worse happened.
1:07:04 - I screwed up, I got a D.W.I.
1:07:08 - In my profession there's just a bunch of drinkers.

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1:07:12 - I ought to learn not to drink so much.
1:07:16 - Pure and simple.
1:07:19 - I won't...(inaudible)

Rosenblum then became concerned about a man video taping the scene. He wanted to know who called the news media. Rosenblum attempted to walk away from the area that was being recorded.
