NARRATIVE

At 1:15 a.m., on 01-11-2012, I received an assignment for a report of a robbery that just occurred at 17416 Chesterfield Airport Road.

Upon my arrival I contacted the restaurant manager, identified as Joshua Evans, who stated an unknown subject had reached across the bar and took money from the cash register. Joshua stated he did not see the incident occur; however, an off the clock employee, identified as Nicholas Stergos, witnessed the whole incident.

I then contacted Nicholas who stated he was sitting right behind the subject. Nicholas stated he overheard the subject on the phone asking for a ride. Nicholas stated the subject then stood up and reached over the bar, grabbed a handful of money from the register and sat back down. Nicholas stated he then stood up and confronted the subject about taking the money. Nicholas stated the subject denied taking the money. Nicholas then informed me he told the subject he was going to call the police and the subject then pulled a handful of money from his pocket and dropped it on the bar. Nicholas stated he told the subject to pay his bill as well and the subject threw three more one dollar bills onto the bar. Nicholas stated he then followed the subject out of the bar and watched him run down Chesterfield Airport Road. Nicholas then stated he went to alert management.

Nicholas described the subject as a white male, approximately 5'8", with short brown hair, wearing a white jacket and blue jeans and tattoos on both his left and right arms.

I then contacted the bartender, identified as Daniel Stergos, who stated the subject arrived at the bar at approximately 12:45 p.m. and was asking strange questions about the bar. Dan stated he was asking questions about when the restaurant closed and what time they started kicking people out. Dan stated he was away from the register cleaning behind the bar and did not see the subject grab the money. Daniel did, however, describe the subject as a white male, wearing a white jacket, with a burgundy t-shirt, blue jeans, with short brown hair and tattoos on both arms.

P.O. Huesgen, DSN 126, responded to process the scene for evidence, see his supplement for further.

I then re-contacted the manager, Joshua, and asked if there were security cameras in the building, to which he replied, there was not. Joshua was also asked to count the cash register drawer to determine the amount that was taken. Upon counting the register, Joshua determined there was \$16 or \$17 missing from the register.

P.O. Huesgen, P.O. Martin DSN 266, and I conducted a canvass of the surrounding area attempting to locate a subject matching the description, which was initially met with negative results.

At 3:01 a.m., P.O. Huesgen and I observed a white male subject wearing a white jacket and blue jeans exit the BP gas station at Long Road and Chesterfield Airport Road. This was directly down the street from the location of occurrence for the Larceny and is also the same direction as the subject was seen running. The male subject then entered a silver Mitsubishi Eclipse convertible bearing Missouri license of [REDACTED]. I then conducted an investigative stop contacting the driver, identified as Lauren Luthans, and the passenger, identified as Theodore Federer. I asked Lauren where she was coming from, to which she stated she received a phone call from her brother, Theodore, from the gas station at Long Road and Chesterfield Airport Road. Lauren stated her brother had called her at about 2:50 a.m. and she got dressed and left.

I then asked Theodore to exit the vehicle and conducted a pat down for weapons. I immediately detected the odor of an intoxicating beverage and observed Theodore's eyes to be bloodshot. I also observed Theodore's clothes to be damp. It could be noted during the two hours between the theft and contact, it had been raining lightly. Theodore was wearing a white jacket, a burgundy t-shirt, blue jeans, had short brown hair and had tattoos on both his right and left arms. I then asked Theodore where he had been tonight, to which he replied he had gone to see a movie at the Galaxy 14 Theater. He stated he had seen the movie "We Bought a Zoo" at 12:00 a.m. with a female friend. Upon utilizing my cell phone to look up movie times, I discovered the final showing for that movie was

at 9:45 p.m. I asked Theodore if he had been to the Fox and the Hound Bar on Chesterfield Airport Road, to which he replied he had not. I then inquired to the whereabouts of his female friend to which he replied he did not know where she was. Theodore stated he had been just been hanging around for the three hours prior to my contacting him, stating he came to the gas station so his sister could pick him up.

Theodore was then placed under arrest utilizing double locked handcuffs behind his back for the charges of Stealing Under \$500 and Minor in Possession of Alcohol by consumption. Theodore was transported to the Chesterfield booking area by P.O. Martin via his patrol vehicle. Theodore was booked under the above charges to be held on \$450 bond. A search was conducted both before and after transport for contraband, and they were met with negative results.

I then contacted Nicholas and Daniel and asked if they would respond to the station to identify the suspect in a photo lineup, to which they both agreed. P.O. Ghassemi, DSN 144, assembled a six photo lineup utilizing the Crime matrix Lynx system with Theodore's photo in the #1 spot. Due to P.O. Wittman, DSN 203, not being involved in the arrest, we had him contact the two witnesses separately utilizing the Chesterfield Police Department Photo Lineup Eyewitness Identification Witness Preparation Form CPD-147. P.O. Wittman showed the witness individual pictures 1 through 6. Daniel identified photo #1 as being the suspect, stating on a scale measuring 1 through 10 with 10 being the highest, he was a level 9 certain. Nicholas identified photo #1 as being the suspect stating on a scale measuring from 1 through 10 with 10 being the highest, he was between an 8 and 9.

I then removed Theodore from the holding cell and placed him in the booking area interview room where his Constitutional Miranda Warning was read and initialed by Theodore. Upon completing the form, Theodore stated he did not want to answer any questions regarding the evening's events.

Summons #21527 and #21528 were completed for Stealing Under \$500 and Minor in Possession of Alcohol respectively with a return court date of 02-21-2012 which will be issued upon release.

Any additional information will be submitted in supplement form.

In reference to a Stealing under \$500.00 at The Fox and Hound I was advised by the bartender Dan Stergos that the suspect involved in the stealing of money from the bar cash drawer had handled two whiskey glasses. One of the glasses was on the bar with the drink still in it and the other glass was put down behind the bar by the bartender after the suspect drank it. Stergos said no one but him and the suspect handled the glasses.

Upon processing the two glasses for latent prints I discovered Latent Prints A, B, C on glass number one which was the one on the bar with the drink in it. Latent Print D was located on the empty Whiskey glass.

Elimination Prints were obtained from the bartender Dan Stergos. The arrested suspect Theodore Federer WM DOB 09-15-1981 was fingerprinted with OCN K3004943.

NARRATIVE

On 02/13/2012 at 2206 hours I received a call for a suspicious vehicle on Greystone Manor Parkway near Grey Eagle Ct. The caller advised a dark colored SUV had been sitting near this location for over an hour and was occupied by multiple individuals. Upon arrival in the area I observed a dark colored GMC Envoy bearing MO Lic. [REDACTED] parked near the above intersection. Upon pulling behind the vehicle, I observed several individuals inside begin to move around. After approximately 15 seconds, I observed four younger white males exit the vehicle. Based upon this, I exited my vehicle and requested they return to their vehicle. The four subjects then began to walk up the sidewalk in my direction. I then advised the four subjects to stop, to which they complied. Upon approaching the four subjects, I detected a noticeable odor of intoxicating beverages coming from their persons.

Based upon this, I asked what they were doing. One of the younger males, later identified as [REDACTED], stated they were just hanging out, but were now walking to a nearby friend's house. During this time, [REDACTED]'s speech was slurred and his eyes appeared glassy. Closer investigation of all four subjects showed their eyes to be glossy, and I continued to smell intoxicating beverages coming from their persons.

During this time, P.O. Hernandez, DSN 5255, arrived on scene. Upon P.O. Hernandez's arrival, I proceeded to the above mentioned vehicle. Upon looking inside, I observed an open silver aluminum can of what appeared to be beer located in the front passenger side floorboard of the vehicle.

A check of the rear passenger seat area showed an open silver and blue box of what appeared to be beer sitting on the rear floorboard. Based upon this, I returned to the subjects and requested their ages. Two stated they were 20, one stated 19 and the fourth stated he was 21.

I then approached one of the young males who had exited from the driver seat. I requested his name. He identified himself as [REDACTED] with a birthdate of 08/07/1991. During this time I could smell intoxicating beverages coming from [REDACTED]'s breath and observed his eyes were glossy.

I then approached another of the male subjects who had exited from the front passenger side. He identified himself as [REDACTED] and provided a birthdate of 09/20/1991. During this time I could smell intoxicating beverages coming from [REDACTED] breath and observed his eyes were glossy.

I then proceeded to ask the third subject his name and date of birth. This subject had exited from the rear of the vehicle. He identified himself as [REDACTED] and provided a birthdate of 06/15/1992. During

this time I continued to observe a strong smell of alcoholic beverages coming from Newsham's person, and his speech was slurred.

During this time P.O. Hernandez had asked the forth subject his name and date of birth. He had identified himself as Nicholas Pontello with a birthdate of 9/14/90. He was the subject who had earlier identified himself as being 21. Allowing this I advised the subjects I believed they had been drinking. All four subjects stated they had not been drinking and there was no alcohol in the vehicle. I then advised the subjects I had seen alcohol in the vehicle. One of the subjects had then stated it was not theirs and it had been there for several days.

Following this I returned to my patrol vehicle where a check of the above mentioned subjects showed an active warrant for Pontello. Following this I returned to the subjects and requested Pontello step forward.

At this time [REDACTED] advised there was no Pontello in the group. Upon confirming via DOR photos that none of the subjects were Nicholas Pontello, I returned to the male who had identified himself as such and informed him of my findings. He stated he had never said his name was Pontello and now identified himself as Theodore Federer with a birth date of 09/15/1991. Based upon this I placed Federer under arrest for providing false information and minor in possession of alcohol. Federer was then handcuffed with cuffs double locked, searched for weapons and placed into the rear passenger seat of vehicle 15.

I then returned to the above mentioned vehicle. Upon entering the vehicle's front passenger side I discovered the above mentioned can was Natural Light beer. I also discovered another unopened can in the same area. A search of the center console found an open and a closed can of Natural Light beer. A search of the rear driver side area found several more cans of opened and unopened Natural Light beer. In this area I also discovered an unopened 1.75 liter bottle of Captain Morgan 100 proof Rum.

A search of the rear passenger side showed the above mentioned open box was a Natural Light Beer 12 pack and contained at least 4 unopened beers of this brand.

Following this I returned to the three remaining subjects. During my time searching the vehicle [REDACTED] had begun to argue with P.O. Hernandez. He advised we had no right to stop them and he would not agree to a charge of minor in possession of alcohol. Based upon this [REDACTED] was advised he was being placed under arrest for Minor in possession of alcohol. He was then handcuffed with cuffs double locked, searched for weapons and placed into the rear seat of vehicle 15.

Following this the above mentioned alcohol was seized and later entered into evidence.

I then transported [REDACTED] and Federer to the Chesterfield Police Department. While transporting [REDACTED] and Federer they began to yell and scream obscenities at me. They also advised me that the Chesterfield Police had nothing better to do than pick up underage people drinking.

They continued in this manner till their arrival at the Chesterfield Police Department.

P.O. Hernandez remained at the scene. He issued [REDACTED] Summons 19321 for Minor in possession of alcohol. He then issued [REDACTED] summons 19322 for Minor in possession of alcohol. These two subjects were then released and proceeded to Federer's nearby address to wait on a ride.

Upon arrival at the Chesterfield Police Department booking area Federer was booked per arrest number 12-181. He was then placed into cell 5 pending bond payment. Federer will be issued summons 21685 for Minor in possession and summons 21686 for providing false information.

Following this [REDACTED] was booked per arrest #12-182. He will be issued summons 21687 for Minor in possession. He was placed into cell 5 pending bond payment. All issued summonses provided a court date of 04/17/2012.

the location. I proceeded to the parking lot of First Community Credit Union.

Upon arrival to the area with PO Beckmann, DSN 5141, PO Smith, DSN 5182, PO Hamel, DSN 5272, PO Brennan, 5236, PO Quach, DSN 5260, Sgt. Dunn, DSN 5196, and Lt. Hufford, DSN 5104, I began checking the parking lot as the subject at last report may have been hiding under a car. The subject was described as a white male with brown hair, a black jacket, and black shorts.

I observed APA Stobart walking south back toward Walmart. I contacted APA Stobart and he entered my patrol vehicle. APA Stobart stated a black Nissan four door had just rounded the corner of the Mobil gas station at a high rate of speed right after he lost visual of the suspect and thought the driver was with the suspect. The vehicle description was broadcast.

During the area canvass, a call came out for PO Quach reference a white male walking along the median of west bound I64. PO Quach responded to the area with negative results for the white male but he did locate a black jacket in the median just across from the Mobil gas station. APA Stobart and I responded and the jacket was identified as belonging to the suspect by Stobart. The jacket was a black, zipper front, Tehama brand, Men's XL with a gray Budweiser Select logo on the upper left chest. The jacket was seized, photographed and placed in evidence.

I then received a phone call from PO Hamel reference the Nissan described above. PO Hamel was flagged down by a citizen at the Hardee's Ice Sports Complex, located on North Outer 40 Road. The unidentified citizen stated a young white male who had walked there had just been picked up by a black Nissan four door bearing MSL [REDACTED] and proceeded west again on North Outer 40 Road.

I proceeded to Wal-Mart and joined PO Paubel. Upon arrival PO Paubel stated he had run the MSL of [REDACTED] for 2013 which returned to a 2003 Nissan Maxima four door registered to a [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] of [REDACTED], Ellisville, MO 63011. PO Paubel also looked up the DOR photograph for owner [REDACTED] (a white male DOB 06/15/1992). I viewed the DOR photo and proceeded inside the store with APA Stobart. Upon entering the Asset Protection Office, APA Stobart reviewed the CCTV surveillance footage of the theft. [REDACTED] was clearly visible leaving the store as APA Stobart was attempting to detain the theft suspect.

APA Stobart provided the following written statement reference the theft, which was seized for placement in evidence.

"Sir,

On 03/29/2012, I Joshua Stobart Asset Protection Associate for Walmart 2600 in Chesterfield, MO was conducting routine surveillance of the store via PTZ (Point Tilt and Zoom) camera from the AP office at the front of the store. At approximately 1623 hours, I observed one unidentified white male subject (who was in his early twenties and wearing a black long-sleeved jacket, as well as black shorts) as he entered the Alcohol aisle of the Grocery department. The subject was carrying a bottle of Coke soda that he had previously selected. I found it suspicious that the unknown subject was wearing a jacket during such warm weather, so I initiated continuous surveillance.

I then observed as the unknown subject selected a bottle of 750 ml "Gentleman Jack" Jack Daniels whiskey from the shelf. The unknown subject then immediately concealed the bottle of whiskey into the front of his shorts, beneath his jacket. The unknown subject then proceeded north to the front of the store and entered into the checkout line for Register 04. I then recruited Customer Service Manager Michelle as my witness. The unknown subject then purchased the bottle of Coke, but failed to offer payment for the bottle of Gentleman Jack whiskey which was concealed under his clothing.

The unknown subject then passed through the EAS pedestals and passed all points of sale without having offered payment for the concealed merchandise. I then approached the unknown subject, along with Michelle as my witness, identified myself as store security, and asked for him to surrender the bottle of alcohol to me. The unknown subject lifted his jacket, removed the bottle of Gentleman Jack whiskey from his shorts, and handed the bottle of whiskey to me. I then asked the subject for his identification and instructed him accompany me back into the store. At this point, the unknown subject attempted to push past me in effort to flee detention.

I instructed the subject to quit resisting as I attempted to restrain the subject, but the subject continued to resist and was able to break free from my hold. As I attempted to keep the subject from fleeing, the bottle of Gentleman Jack whiskey was knocked from my hand and shattered on the floor. I then followed behind the subject out to the parking lot and notified Officer Paubel DSN 242 of the fleeing shoplifter and communicated the subject's direction of travel to Officer Paubel. As we began to run away from the store, into the parking lot, another subject, later identified as [REDACTED], began to run along side of the unknown subject. [REDACTED] then spoke to the unknown subject and said, "Just keep going buddy." I then instructed [REDACTED] to stay at the store and continued to follow on foot behind the unknown subject while advising Officer Paubel of his current location.

The unknown subject then traveled north, across THF Boulevard, across Chesterfield Airport Road, and entered into the parking lot of the First Community Bank. At this point, I lost sight of the unknown subject, but continued to travel north through the parking lot of the First Community Bank. As I approached the northern end of the parking lot for the First Community Bank, I observed [REDACTED] who was driving a black Nissan Maxima. [REDACTED] was driving slow and appeared to be looking for the unknown subject. When [REDACTED] saw me, he drove away at a high speed, traveling east behind the First Community Bank.

Several Chesterfield Police Officers arrived on scene shortly after Newsham departed. As the officers arrived, I advised them of what I had seen. Officer Chad Meyer DSN 238 then arrived on scene at the First Community Bank and transported me to the left shoulder of Highway 64/40 westbound, where I was able to identify the discarded jacket that had been worn by the unknown subject during his theft of the bottle of Gentleman Jack whiskey.

I then called the Chesterfield Walmart and advised CSM Michelle, who had been my witness for the attempted apprehension, that she should secure the broken bottle of whiskey in the CSM office for evidence. Michelle advised that she would secure the broken bottle of whiskey, as well as the shoe of the unknown subject, which had been left behind as he ran away from the store. It was then made known to Officer Meyer and I that [REDACTED] had been observed picking up the unknown subject at the Hardee's Ice Arena and that [REDACTED]'s license plate number had been recorded.

Officer Meyer and I then met Officer Paubel back at Walmart so that proper paperwork could be completed. I pulled the video surveillance and provided Officer Meyer with a picture of the unknown subject who had committed the theft.

The theft totaled at \$27.97 and is as follows:

APA Stobart provided me with the suspect's shoe, a CD-R containing CCTV surveillance footage, photographs of the broken bottle of Gentleman Jack; an unbroken bottle (for comparison); the suspects shoe; and a video still of the Nissan bearing MSL [REDACTED] in the parking lot of Walmart. All were seized for placement in evidence. Also provided was a receipt copy of the coke purchase using a debit card ending 1313 for \$1.41. The copy was seized and placed into evidence.

Ellisville PD was notified of the incident and responded to the address listed above of the vehicle owner with negative results.

PO Paubel and I proceeded to the Chesterfield Police Station to investigate further.

Upon arrival, I checked Crime Matrix for information on [REDACTED]. I found a home phone number of (314) [REDACTED] and a cell phone number of (314) [REDACTED] listed. I contacted the home number first and spoke with [REDACTED] father [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated the number I contacted was his cell phone and [REDACTED] had not been home in two days. [REDACTED] stated he would attempt to contact his son and have him turn himself in. I contacted the listed cell phone number and received a message from the carrier which stated the subscriber was not accepting calls at this time.

I then conducted a Lynx Analysis on [REDACTED] and located a Theodore Thomas Federer (a white male DOB 09/15/1991) in Crime Matrix. Theodore Giles Federer stated the second number was his home number.

With the permission of Sgt. Dunn, a wanted was entered for the charge of Stealing for both [REDACTED] (Clerk DSN 3908 and TT #540) and Theodore Thomas Federer (Clerk DSN 3908 and TT #541). The vehicle was also entered as wanted through St. Louis County Clerk DSN 3908 and TT #540 with instructions to arrest the occupants if they were the suspects listed above.

An additional charge of Destruction of Property will be sought reference the broken/unsellable bottle of Gentleman Jack whiskey.
